The pastors are looking forward to having Tony and Bob spend some time with them and to help guide them in the decision making process.

Tony has also been asked to be part of the board of directors for the work in Medellin, (northwest of Bogota). The challenge of Christians in Action is to plant 60 new churches by 2015. Each student from CinA’s Missions Institute in Medellin must help establish a new church to graduate.
