They felt that it would be safer not to hold our youth conference there. We decided that we would trust the Lord for a wonderful conference at our main church in San Pedro.

Saturday we started our conference with a full house, even coming from over the mountains to be with us. The Holy Spirit touched everyone's heart and you could hear the singing and praising for miles around.



They gathered around tables for the class session; they were listening and faithfully taking notes. The evening services on Saturday and Sunday were powerful with many giving testimonies of what this conference meant to them. Praise the Lord for His faithfulness.

A couple of days before my flight home Expedia contacted Margaret to tell her that Mexicana wasn't making any more flights and that we would have to buy another ticket. It cost \$600 for a one way ticket to Los Angeles. We're praying that we can get some of that money back as we had to put it on our credit card.



Heidi is home now and working on finishing up some of the ten books that are required reading before she arrives in Africa. She will also be sharing in churches and home meetings raising the last of the support she needs. Today she paid her
